



Schooling Shows THE 2006 SERIES

THE TGIF FUN SHOW SERIES began in May 1979 and has become a Friday night summertime tradition at Centaur. Unlike the highly competitive atmosphere of an "A" Show, the TGIF is meant to encourage inexperienced riders. Green horses should not enter.

DATES

- May 7 (afternoon only), July 7, July 21, August 11, September 1.

CLASSES

Class 1 CENTAUR NEWCOMER DRESSAGE TEST - Walk & Trot. This class is designed to inaugurate riders to dressage competition. See Rules for definition of Newcomer. Horses may be at any level of training. Test available at www.centaurridingschool.com.

Class 2 CENTAUR BASIC 1 RIDER DRESSAGE TEST for the NOVICE Rider

See Rules for definition of Novice. Horses may be at any level of training. Test available at www.centaurridingschool.com.

Class 3 "PICK-A-DRESSAGE-TEST"

Dressage test will be ridden in a 20 x 40 meter ring. There is a variety of tests available at www.centaurridingschool.com and cadora.ca. These tests are free for you to use. If you choose another test, ensure you have legal rights to using chosen test. (EC 2003 tests are not allowed). Let us know on the entry form which test you have chosen. Winners will be decided by percentage. Open to all. (Newcomers may enter if walk/trot test is chosen)

Class 4 NEWCOMER DRESSAGE EQUITATION Walk & Trot.

See Rules for definition of Newcomer. Competitors may also enter classes 1, 3 (if walk/trot test), 5 & 13 but are not eligible for other classes.

Class 5 NEWCOMER COMMAND CLASS Walk & Trot

See Rules for definition of Newcomer. Rough riding will be eliminated. Riders in this class may also enter classes 1, 3 (if walk/trot test), 4 & 13 but are not eligible for other classes.

Class 6 NOVICE DRESSAGE EQUITATION See Rules for definition of Novice

Class 7 NOVICE COMMAND CLASS See Rules for definition of Novice. Rough riding will be eliminated.

Class 8 OPEN DRESSAGE EQUITATION

Class 9 HUNTER UNDER SADDLE - Open

Class 10 EQUITATION OVER FENCES - Open (max. height 2')

Class 11 HUNTER OVER FENCES - Open (max. height 2')

Class 12 HUNTER OVER FENCES - Open (max. height 2'3")

Class 13 NEWCOMER EQUITATION OVER FENCES (Max. height 1'6").

Riders may not enter other 'Over/Fences' classes and must never have completed a course other than "Novice or Newcomer O/F" prior to this year. Trotting on course allowed.

TIMES

- For evening shows: Dressage classes start at 5:30 pm, Hunter classes at 6:00 pm.
- Warm-up Hunter Over Fences is held between 5:30 and 6:00 pm.
- Day before show, riding times will be posted at www.centaurridingschool.com.

ENTRIES

- FEES: Classes 1, 2, 3: \$18.00/ class
Classes 4 -13: \$10.00/ class
Warm-up Hunter: \$2.00 per round, to be paid upon entering the ring.
(Warm-up Hunter is only for horses already entered in an "over fences" class.)
- GST is payable on all entry fees. There is no GST on Administration fees.
- Post entries, faxed, and late and/or phone entries add \$20.00 flat fee for the show.
- **ENTRIES AND ALL FEES MUST BE RECEIVED BY THE SUNDAY BEFORE THE SHOW.**
(Entries for Centaur School Riders close two Sundays before the Show.)
- Make cheques payable to Shirley Guertin. No post-dated cheques.
- Mail entries to Centaur Riding School, 3845 Frank Kenny Rd. Navan, Ont., K4B 1H9
- A FEE of \$25.00 will be charged for cheques that are returned from the bank for any reason.
- Phone-in entries who do not pay before the show will be held accountable for their entries even if they do not come to the show. Until all accounts are cleared the competitor will not be accepted for further competition at Centaur nor will be eligible for year-end awards.

RULES

- A copy of a current year negative Coggins Test for each horse must accompany entries.
- Riders must wear protective headgear (EC Rules) and proper footwear at all times while mounted. Juniors **MUST** (Ont. Law) wear an approved helmet at all times while mounted.
- Riders must wear their numbers at all times while riding.
- Entries in dressage tests may be limited.
- The same horse may be ridden by two different riders in Classes 1, 3 and 13.
- Boots and bandages will be allowed in the over fences classes but not in any of the flat classes. Martingales in flat classes will be allowed only in Newcomer classes.
- Hors Concours entries will not be accepted.
- In case of rain, the show will still be held, with jumping classes being held indoors.
- Refund arrangements for scratched horses must be made directly with Shirley Guertin before the date of the show. With a vet certificate, all fees, less a \$25.00 scratch fee, will be credited to a later show. There are no refunds for "no shows".

- **STABLING:** The cost is \$35.00 per box stall and \$30.00 per standing stall per day, or part of a day. Initial bedding is included. Fees must be paid in advance to reserve space. Stalls are extremely limited. Any refunds will be in the form of a credit note. Please indicate time of arrival & departure. **SEND STABLING FEE ON A SEPARATE CHEQUE.** Stall sharing is not allowed and stall lessee will be billed for any other horses occupying their space during the competition. *Stalls will be reserved only after all conditions are met.*
